

Welsh Economic Resilience Grant for Hospitality, Tourism and Leisure sectors

The most recent Welsh Economic Resilience Grant for Hospitality, Tourism and Leisure sectors (together with supply chains) is due to open for new applications on Monday 11 January.

This grant is aimed at businesses from these sectors which have been materially affected by the lockdown who have experienced a 60% reduction in turnover.

It may be worth considering whether your business could qualify for the grants, including whether it qualifies as part of the supply chain, by reviewing the application criteria shown on the website. If your business is eligible you will need to apply as soon as practical on Monday, as previous similar grants have been fully allocated very quickly after opening.

You should also check your local councils' website to determine whether you are eligible for any other Covid related local grants, some of which you may have to apply for via the council

Following the recent announcements in England, there may be changes to the current grants, or possibly more grants available, in Wales soon and the Business Wales website is the key source of information for such grants.
